



City of Prichard Trash Regulations

Trash is leaves, tree cuttings, grass, appliances and furniture. According to the city of Prichard ordinance #1712 P the rules are as follows:

(4 cubic yards= Six Allied Waste trash carts side by side or 15 bags of trash.)

1. No trash pile shall exceed more than 4 cubic yards per week. (Six Allied Waste trash carts side by side), must not be out no more than 48 hours before your service day.
2. Construction debris- (inside or outside) - you are responsible for disposing of this debris, or you may call Public Works for a special pickup. \$250.00 for the first haul, \$50.00 for each additional haul.
3. All tree cutting shall not exceed 4 cubic yards, 8 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter and no more than 80 pounds.
4. Tires- This is an automatic fine. You are responsible for disposing of this debris, and encouraged to take the tires to a facility that will accept them.
5. Appliances- All appliances must not exceed 4 cubic yards. FREON must be removed from refrigerators and freezers before being picked up by the city.
6. Furniture- Must not exceed 4 cubic yards.
7. Garbage mixed with trash- This is an automatic fine. Please make sure you put all your garbage in your garbage cart.
8. Loose Trash- All grass clippings, leaves, straw pines, old clothes, etc. must be bagged and shall not exceed 4 cubic yards per week.
9. Placement of Trash- All trash must be four feet away from parked vehicles, mailboxes, fences, utility poles, fire hydrants, and should not be placed under trees or power lines, in order to be serviced.
10. Vacant Houses/ Lots- The owners are responsible for maintaining and disposing of garbage and trash. If the lots are not maintained by the owner, the city of Prichard will take action and/or will clean the lot and bill the owner.

11. Hazardous Waste- (Paint, Oil, Batteries, etc.)- This is an automatic fine. You are responsible for disposing of this debris. For safety and health reasons, you are encouraged to take this debris to a facility that will accept hazardous waste.

12. Businesses and Churches- Are responsible for maintaining and disposing of their own garbage and trash. You are encouraged to keep a dumpster on the premises. Public Works will make a special pickup for a fee. \$250.00 for the first haul, \$50.00 for each additional haul.
